Paper 2: Performing I (20%)

- two or more pieces in an instrumental or vocal <u>ensemble</u> in contrasting styles in a recital (<u>15%</u>), range from <u>10 to 15 minutes</u>, and
- **2.** <u>viva voce</u> lasting for <u>**3 to 5 minutes** (3%);</u>
- **3.** <u>sing at sight</u> a tonal melody of <u>**8 to 12 bars** (2%)</u>.

basic requirements of this Paper are comparable to the Grade 4 practical examination of the ABRSM

Paper 3: Creating I (20%)

- two or more compositions (16%),
- the total duration of which should be approximately
 6 to 15 minutes,
- with at least one composition scored for an ensemble;
- a reflective report (4%) of about 500 words.

Paper 4C: Creating II (20%)

- two music arrangements of specific tasks, the total duration of which should range from 8 to 18 minutes (16%):
 - (1) to arrange an instrumental piece for a different instrumentation, and
 - (2) to add accompaniment and extension to an existing song or melody.

Candidates should make the arrangement on an original piece, and that the score of the original piece has to be submitted together with the arrangement; and

• a reflective report (4%) of about 600 words.

Paper 4A: Special Project (20%)

- Candidates have to submit a written report of 3,000 to 5,000 words to discuss the musical and cultural context of a particular topic for external assessment.
- The procedure of seeking approval by the HKEAA in advance for the Special Project topic is abolished.



Paper 4B: Performing II (20%)

- sing or play three or more pieces individually in contrasting styles in a recital (18%), the duration of which should range from 10 to 20 minutes, and take part in a viva voce lasting for 3 to 5 minutes to explain their understanding and interpretation of the music performed (2%)
- basic requirements of this paper are comparable to the Grade 6 practical examination of the ABRSM
- Applying for Exemption or sitting a Practical examination
