| Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University?  | <p>Not generally.</p> <p>The only entrance requirement we have that may affect students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications is in the area of English language proficiency (see below).</p>   |   |
| Is there a language proficiency test that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must take?                   | We prefer students to have taken IELTS, TOEFL or another recognised international test, although students with good grades in HKAS Level Use of English at C or above will also be considered.  |   |
| Is there a standard on an international English scale that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must reach? | This varies from course to course, but as a general rule it is unlikely that we would admit any student with less than IELTS 6 or equivalent.   |   |
