Does your University accept the HKCEE and HKALE for admission to your University?	Yes. HKCEE grades are considered to be directly equivalent to GCSE exams. The HKALE grades are equivalent to GCE A-level grades. In science and maths it is recognised that a grade B would be equivalent to an A grade in GCE A-level.
What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University?	Each course has individual entrance requirements. These can be found in our prospectus or online. www.qmul.ac.uk
Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University?	No. Entry is based on the grades obtained in HKALE and HKCEE.
Is there a language proficiency test that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must take?	If a student has English of grade C or above in the Hong Kong Certificate of Education (Syllabus B only) and or grade C or above in HK AS Level use of English they should not be required to pass IELTS or TOEFL exams for entry into Queen Mary undergraduate courses.
Is there a standard on an international English scale that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must reach?	If a student has English of grade C or above in the Hong Kong Certificate of Education (Syllabus B only) and or grade C or above in HK AS Level use of English they should not be required to pass IELTS or TOEFL exams for entry into Queen Mary undergraduate courses.
Are there any other tests that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must take? When must they be taken?	No
Is there an entry quota that applies to students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University?	No, unless they are applying to study Medicine or Dentistry. These subjects have a restriction on the number places awarded to non-EU students. The quota is imposed by the UK government and is currently set at 17 students for Medicine and 3 for Dentistry.

Is consideration given to factors other than examination performance for overseas students wishing to apply for entry to your University?	The main factor under consideration is examination performance, however we also consider the academic reference and personal statement.
Does your University accept the International Baccalaureate?	Yes. Grades for entry with the International Baccalaureate differ for each subject. This information can be found in the prospectus. Students should offer the full IB and the points required are between 30 and 36.
Does your University accept students if they are under the age of 18 at the time of commencing studies?	Yes, but it is preferable that students under the age of 18 are living with a parent or guardian.
