Is consideration given to factors other than examination performance for overseas students wishing to apply for entry to your University/College?	<p>The primary consideration is given to a student's academic profile which covers all levels of academic achievement including the results at HKCEE and the predicted or achieved grades at HKALE.</p> <p>The UCAS personal statement and academic reference are taken into consideration if the minimum academic entry requirements have been met.</p> <p>For professional degrees such as medicine and veterinary medicine, it is crucial to provide insight into relevant work experience and career exploration.</p> <p>For entry to Fine Art a portfolio must be submitted.</p> <p>Entry to teacher training will require an interview.</p>
