	Applicants must submit an official transcript/ mark sheet from last high school/ secondary school attended, showing all years of the student's grades.
	If a student is currently enrolled in school, in-progress transcripts/ mark sheets through the junior year (11 th grade or equivalent) will be sufficient for initial admission review. Prior to enrollment, SCAD must receive proof of completion of the high school/ secondary school program (or for home-schooled applicants, correspondence school or other accredited private home school).
	The Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (Form V) completed with at least five subject areas passed is the equivalent of a diploma from a U.S. high school. All transcripts/ mark sheets must be in English or accompanied by a certified English translation. A certificate of General Educational Development from the American Council of Education is considered equivalent to a diploma from a U.S. high school.
	For applicants from countries other than the United States, SCAD uses the standards established by the National Association of Foreign Student Advisors and the American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers to determine the equivalent academic achievement.
Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University/College?	No, they do not.

	Applicants who meet or exceed all other SCAD admission requirements, but do not demonstrate English proficiency through minimum TOEFL, IELTS, ACTFL or SAT scores, may be admitted to the SCAD English as a Second Language (ESL) program. These students must take a SCAD English language proficiency test to be placed in the appropriate level of ESL. Student must satisfactorily complete the ESL program through Level IV prior to advancing into any academic course of study at SCAD and must continue taking ESL through satisfactory completion of Level VI.
