Does your University/College accept the HKCEE and HKALE for admission to your University/College?	Yes.
What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University/College?	A very minimum of 5 subjects with grades of A, B, C or D; HKALE not required of admission but may elicit advanced standing credit
Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University/College?	No, but students do need TOEFL, IELTS or SAT scores submitted with their application.
Is there a language proficiency test that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must take?	Yes. High School students must present a TOEFL, IELTS or SAT score to demonstrate English Proficiency. University students applying as transfer students need only show a passing score in a University-level English composition course.
Is there a standard on an international English scale that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must reach?	<u>TOEFL</u> : 61 IBT minimum 500 PBT minimum <u>IELTS</u> : 5.0 minimum <u>SAT</u> : 500 on Critical Reading minimum
Are there any other tests that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must take? When must they be taken?	Students interested in Biological Sciences or Chemistry, are encouraged to take the SAT II Chemistry Subject Test.
Is there an entry quota that applies to students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College?	No.
Where can information be obtained on fees and other charges for students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College?	There are no additional fees for students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications. The online application is free: www.pacific.edu/apply
Is consideration given to factors other than examination performance for overseas students wishing to apply for entry to your University/College?	Yes. We review all items included in the application file.
Does your University/College accept the International Baccalaureate?	Yes.
Does your University/College accept students if they are under the age of 18 at the time of commencing studies?	Yes, but we prefer that the student is at least 18 years of age if they will be living on campus.
