### Thirty-three Schools Accredited for Quality Assessment Management

In recognition of their commitment to quality examination and assessment management, 33 primary and secondary schools were accredited in the 2019 Quality Assessment Management Accreditation Scheme (QAMAS) offered by the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA).

Among the accredited schools this year, 31 of them have joined the QAMAS for five to ten years and have their accreditation renewed. In his welcoming remarks during the certificate presentation ceremony today (2 November 2019), Mr Samuel Yung Wing-ki, Chairman of the HKEAA, appreciated the continued support from the accredited schools and the dedication of these schools in continuous improvement of their examination and assessment management.

Following the certificate presentation ceremony hosted by Mr Ng Ka-shing, Principal Assistant Secretary of the Education Bureau, and Dr So Kwok-sang, Secretary General of the HKEAA, the representatives of Lok Sin Tong Leung Kau Kui Primary School shared their experience in enhancing feedback for parents through qualitative results reporting. The QAMAS project team of the HKEAA also gave a talk on risk management of school internal assessments.

About 100 principals and teachers attended the event held at STFA Leung Kit Wah Primary School today.
