Seven Schools Accredited under the QAMAS Organised by the HKEAA

The Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) has granted another seven primary and secondary schools accreditation under the Quality Assessment Management Accreditation Scheme (QAMAS) this year. More than 100 primary and secondary schools were accredited since the launch of this scheme in 2007.

Representatives from the accredited schools were presented with certificates today (5 November 2016) by Mr Rock Chen Chung-nin, Chairman of the HKEAA, Dr Tong Chong-sze, Secretary General and Mr Sheridan Lee Sha-lun, Principal Assistant Secretary (Curriculum Development) of the Education Bureau, in recognition of their commitment to provide quality examination and assessment management in schools.

Over a hundred teachers from the accredited schools attended the ceremony and representative of Sham Tseng Catholic Primary School shared their experience in delivering internal assessment.

The scheme aims at promoting assessment management literacy and the establishment of a systematic mechanism for continuous improvement among participating schools. The HKEAA supports participating schools by providing guidance on assessment management as well as relevant training for their teaching staff.
