

Frequently Asked Questions:

Estate Agents Qualifying Examination / Salespersons Qualifying Examination

1. Can I register for both Estate Agents Qualifying Examination and Salespersons Qualifying Examination in the same session?

No, candidates cannot register for both Estate Agents Qualifying Examination and Salespersons Qualifying Examination in the same session as the registration periods are different. For example, in-person registration for Estate Agents Qualifying Examination June 2012 will be 26 April 2012 to 3 May 2012, but Salespersons Qualifying Examination June 2012 will be 10 May 2012 to 16 May 2012.

2. When will the examination result be available?

Individual result slips will be posted to you within three to five weeks after the examination. However, if you indicate your agreement to posting your examination results online on the entry form, you could check your examination results on the Estate Agents Authority website: <http://www.eaa.org.hk>

3. When will the examinations be held in 2012?

Estate Agents Qualifying Examination will be held four times in 2012 (February 16, June 8, October 5 and December 14) and Salespersons Qualifying Examination will be held six times in 2012 (February 17, April 20, June 22, August 24, October 19 and December 28).
