Temporary Officer – Education Assessment Services (Contract period up to 31 December 2021)

Duties: The appointee will be responsible for converting assessment items from paper mode to web mode on provided computers and web platforms as well as processing data and documents.

Requirements:

- (a) A Higher Diploma or above in Information Technology, Computer Science or other relevant disciplines or equivalent;
- (b) Solid working experiences in XML, CSS, and HTML;
- (c) Proficient in computer software including Microsoft Office, Excel;
- (d) Good command of spoken and written English and Chinese;
- (e) A meticulous team player with good interpersonal and communication skills;
- (f) Able to work independently and under tight timeline;
- (g) Be able to work full time throughout the appointment period;
- (h) Candidates with less academic qualifications but strong technical skills may be considered.

Employment Terms: The remuneration package will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Appointment will be on a temporary contract with MPF benefits.

Applications would be considered until the post is filled.
