Dear Principal,

Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination 2026 Administrative Arrangements for Music

I would like to draw your attention to the administrative arrangements regarding the submission of performance, creating portfolios and project reports for the 2026 HKDSE Music examination:

(1) According to the **2026 HKDSE Assessment Framework for Music**, the requirements for Paper 2 and Paper 3 remain the same as last examination year. The total duration of the ensemble performance in **Paper 2 (Performing I)** is **6 to 12 minutes**, while the compositions in **Paper 3 (Creating I)** should last **between 6 to 15 minutes**. Please note that this is the last examination year to adopt the above requirements and the revised Assessment Framework will be implemented in the 2027 HKDSE. - (2) Candidates are requested to use the same language they have chosen for the Music examination in all parts of the papers (including oral presentation in Paper 2, viva voce in Paper 4B and reflective reports in Papers 3 and 4C).
- (3) The following details for the 2026 HKDSE Music Examination are provided in the **Annex** for your reference:
 - (i) the submission schedule and a checklist of the items to be submitted for Papers 2 to 4C; and
 - (ii) the tentative practical examination period for Paper 4B.

Further details of the examination and submission guidelines for Papers 2 to 4C will be announced on the HKEAA website in due course. Kindly draw the attention of your teacher(s) and student(s) concerned to the above matter.
