Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination 2014 Examination Circular No. (1) 2013/2014 Applications for Special Examination Arrangements from Candidates with Special Needs

- 1. Candidates with special needs (such as candidates with disabilities/chronic illness) may apply for special examination arrangements (e.g. allocation to special centres, extra time allowance, supervised breaks, provision of Braille/enlarged question papers) or exemption from part(s) of the requirements of an examination in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination. School candidates should submit their applications to the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) via schools.
- 2. To enable schools to have adequate time to implement the approved special examination arrangements in internal examinations, candidates should submit applications two years before they sit for the HKDSE Examination (i.e. in S5) so that they can be notified of the application results within that school year. Upon receipt of the application results, schools should implement the approved special examination arrangements in tests / examinations in school soonest possible so that the candidates can familiarize themselves with the arrangements. In case the candidates' conditions of disabilities are unstable, they may submit applications in the school year they sit the HKDSE Examination.

Timeline	Application Procedures
From Monday, 9 September 2013 to Friday, 27 September 2013	School candidates and private candidates can submit applications for special examination arrangements.
December 2013 to mid-January 2014	All applications are considered by the Committee on Special Needs Candidates or the Task Group on Special Examination Arrangements for Candidates with Specific Learning Disabilities. The HKEAA will announce the results of the applications via the SEA Online Services. The candidates will also receive notification of results in writing.
Within 4 weeks from the date of issue of notification letter	Candidates who are not satisfied with the results of their applications may apply for review within 4 weeks from the date of notification of results. Applications for review must be supported by additional justifications and / or documentary evidence in writing.
March 2014	Applications for review are processed by an independent "Appeal Panel for Special Needs Candidates". Applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of the review in early March 2014.

Special Examination Arrangements (SEA) Online Services

- 4. Schools should submit applications for their students through the SEA Online Services at the HKDSE Examination Online Services (<u>www.hkdse.hkeaa.edu.hk</u>). School Principals can login the HKDSE Examination Online Services by using the same User IDs and login passwords as those for the SBA system and the Registration System for HKDSE. Apart from the School Principal, each school should designate one school staff as the SEA Application Officer who should continue to use the same user ID and login password he/she has been using in the 2013 HKDSE Examination. For School Principals / SEA Application Officers who have lost their user IDs / login passwords, please contact the Public Examinations Information Centre of the HKEAA on 3628 8860.
- 5. Applications of the following candidates should be submitted via the SEA Online Services to the HKEAA together with the supporting documents from Monday, 9 September 2013 to Friday, 27 September 2013:
 - candidates with special needs who will be studying S6 in 2013/14 and have not submitted their applications before (i.e. candidates who will sit the 2014 HKDSE Examination)
 - candidates with special needs who will be studying S5 in 2013/14 (i.e. candidates who will sit the 2015 HKDSE Examination)

Late applications will **NOT** be processed.
