
Development and Recognition of HKDSE

50,803 candidates entered the 2024 HKDSE, with 43,300 school candidates






Students' Pathway




Secondary 6 Graduates/ HKDSE Holders Pursuing Further Study Outside Hong Kong

Increasing number of non-HKID candidates taking the HKDSE






