Please note that different programs have varying entry requirements as well as some with prerequisites.</p> <p>Other points are:</p> <p>All subjects must be taken in the one year. (Not necessarily calendar year)</p> <p>Calculations: A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1</p> <p>For Pure or Applied Maths, Biology, Physics or Chemistry add 1 bonus point to the calculation.</p> <p>Advanced Supplementary (AS) subjects may be included in the aggregate and contribute the equivalent of half of a subject taken at Advanced Level: A = 2.5, B = 2, C = 1.5, D = 1, E = 0.5</p> <p>'Results Notice' acceptable</p> <p>UAC schedule conversion used</p>	<p>HKCEE Form 5 grade D in 4 subjects (excluding English but can include Chinese) AND Grade 3 in English with a 3 or better in writing OR IELTS 5.5 (minimum 5 in all bands).</p> <p>Admission requirements into ANU Programs following the Foundation Program can be provided if required.</p>
