Does your University/College accept the HKCEE and HKALE for admission to your University/College?	HKALE qualifications are accepted for admission to Curtin University Bachelor degree programs.
What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University/College?	<p>The minimum requirement for HKALE holders is a score of five points from at least two Advanced Level subjects using the calculation of grade A = 5 pts, B = 4, C = 3, D = 2, E = 1</p> <p>HKALE entry requirements vary depending on the academic program applied for, specific entry requirements for all of Curtin University's courses can be found at <a href="http://www.courses.curtin.edu.au">www.courses.curtin.edu.au</a></p>
Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University/College?	Students applying for direct entry to the University with suitable HKALE grades or other acceptable academic qualifications, are not required to sit any additional entrance examinations.
Is there a language proficiency test that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must take?	A minimum of HKCEE English Language (Syllabus B) grade C or from 2007 a grade of 3 in English Language will satisfy Curtin University's minimum English requirements.
Is there a standard on an international English scale that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must reach?	Applicants who have not met Curtin University's English requirements through HKCEE may sit one of many English tests or programs, a full list of Curtin's English requirements can be found at <a href="http://www.international.curtin.edu.au/documents/MinEnglishLangReqs2011.pdf">www.international.curtin.edu.au/documents/MinEnglishLangReqs2011.pdf</a>
Are there any other tests that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must take? When must they be taken?	Applicants who satisfy Curtin University's entry requirements are not required to undertake any further testing.
Is there an entry quota that applies to students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College?	There is no specific entry quota for students with HKALE Qualifications seeking entry to Curtin University. There are quotas for some courses but these are not specific to entry qualifications.

Is consideration given to factors other than examination performance for overseas students wishing to apply for entry to your University/College?	Whilst selection for entry into most degrees at Curtin University is based entirely upon academic merit, there are select courses that consider factors beyond examination performance such as interview or portfolio requirements.

<p>Does your University/College accept the International Baccalaureate?</p>	<p>Yes, the University accepts the International Baccalaureate Diploma. <p>Does your University/College accept students if they are under the age of 18 at the time of commencing studies?</p>	<p>Admission to Curtin University is based upon academic merit rather than age. Students under the age of 18 at the time of commencing studies are permitted to enrol at Curtin University providing they have satisfied the Australian Commonwealth Government's requirements in order to be issued a student visa.
