Does your University/College accept the HKCEE and HKALE for admission to your University/College?	Yes HKALE are accepted for degree programs. Students with HKCEE may be referred to Queensland Institute of Business & Technology (QIBT) for pathway programs.
What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University/College?	HKALE entry requirements vary from program to program. The minimum requirement is 5 points from HKALE and a minimum of 2 HKALE 'A' level subjects. Some programs require higher scores.
Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University/College?	Students with HKALE qualification DO NOT have to sit for an entrance examination.
Is there a language proficiency test that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must take?	Students with HKALE qualifications DO NOT need a language proficiency test.
Is there a standard on an international English scale that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must reach?	NO
Are there any other tests that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College must take? When must they be taken?	For the majority of programs, students DO NOT need to sit for any additional tests. There are some health programs such as Dentistry and Medicine which require students to sit for a UMAT or ISAT.
Is there an entry quota that applies to students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University/College?	No entry quota applies to students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter Griffith University

Is consideration given to factors other than examination performance for overseas students wishing to apply for entry to your University/College?	In general, the admission to a program is based mostly on academic merit. Sometimes, special consideration may be given to related work experience for a few programs. In addition, there are a few programs (creative arts and music), that require a folio.
