What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University?	<p>HKALE entry requirements vary depending on academic program. Usually for minimum entry to the University, two C-grade passes for a minimum of 2 academic subjects at Advanced level are acceptable. Some programs, such as Law, Veterinary Science, and Chiropractic have slightly higher entry requirements. Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University?	Students applying for direct entry to the University with suitable HKALE grades or other acceptable academic qualifications, are not required sit any additional entrance examinations
Is there a language proficiency test that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must take?	<p>- IELTS overall band score of 6.0 (plus each individual band scoring no less than 6) - TOEFL (computer-based) score of 213 (plus an Essay Rating score of 5 or better)</p> <p>Murdoch Language Institute does offer English language programs if students do not meet the University's proficiency requirements. Is there a standard on an international English scale that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must reach?	Please refer to the above
