What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University/College?	Satisfactory completion of high school study with HKAL examination results. Entry requirements vary across programs. Detailed entry requirements and bonus points is available at: http://www.international.unsw.edu.au/study/degree-programs/undergraduate/undergraduate-degree-entry-requirements/	Transition program requirements: HKALE (where A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1) – score of 5 or more with minimum of 3 points from A-levels and 2 points from AS levels(counting AS grades as half score). Some subjects receive a bonus point. Some streams of study have subject specific requirements. Standard and Standard Plus program requirements: HKALE grades will be considered in conjunction with HKCEE grades. HKCEE (where A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1) – score of 10 or more over 4 best academic subjects for the Standard program and score of 8-9 for the Standard Plus program. Some streams of study have subject-specific requirements. HKALE – a minimum of grade C in Use of English or satisfactory English test results : http://www.unsw.edu.au/english-requirements-policy	Transition program requirements: HK AS level – D grade or better overall or IELTS 6.0 (with consistent sub-scores) Standard and Standard Plus program requirements: A minimum HKALE Use of English grade E overall with consistent sub-scores; or HKCEE English Language Grade 3 overall (with consistent sub-scores, ie not more than one sub-score at 2 or lower; or IELTS with a minimum score of 5.5 and individual bands not less than 5.0 or other acceptable test of English language at the same standard.
