All applicants must demonstrate their strengths in their chosen specialism – methods we use to assess this include auditions, interviews and portfolios.

Students applying to all courses except Music Business should have a good understanding of music theory, and we expect students applying to performance based courses to also possess a very high level of practical skill on their instrument.  Students applying for Music Business should possess an understanding of the music industry and entrepreneurship. Musical ability could prove useful for a Music Business applicant, but is not required.
