Does your University accept the HKCEE and HKALE for admission to your University?	Yes. HKCEE grades are considered direct equivalents to GCSE exams. The HKALE grades are equivalent to GCE A-level (apart from mathematics and science subjects where admissions tutors would normally recognize that a B grade in HKALE is equivalent to an A grade at A-level and, similarly, a C grade in HKALE is equivalent to a B grade at A-level).
What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University?	<p>HKALE grades AAA – BCC (unless mathematics or science subjects for which B or C grades would normally be acceptable in place of A and B grades respectively). The precise grades depend on the degree programme applied for</p> <p>HKCEE in a broad range of subjects – the majority should be grade B or higher.</p> <p>Some of the degree courses have subject-specific requirements at both HKALE and HKCEE; details can be found in our prospectus or online www.lboro.ac.uk</p>
Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University?	No
Is there a language proficiency test that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must take?	<p>An English language qualification is essential and Loughborough University accepts a wide range of English language qualifications as suitable for entry to Loughborough University.</p> <p>These include at least a grade C in HKCEE English Language syllabus B or HKALE Use of English: Grade E or better.</p> <p>If applicants do not possess either of these HK-based qualifications alternative English Language proficiency examination such as IELTS or TOEFL are acceptable.</p> <p>There are a wide range of other options which are listed on our website http://lboro.ac.uk/admin/ar/international/prospective/englishlang/</p>
Is there a standard on an international English scale that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must reach?	<p>Yes</p> <p>HKCEE English Language syllabus B a grade C</p> <p>HKALE Use of English: Grade E or better</p> <p>IELTS 6.5, TOEFL 600 (or 250 computer based)</p>

These are all included on a UCAS application and include the personal statement and the academic reference.</p> <p>For some subjects such as Art and Design submission of a portfolio of work is important, whilst for others such as Drama an audition may be necessary.</p> <p>Clear details of admissions requirements other than examination performance can be found in our prospectus and on our website.</p> <p>www.lboro.ac.uk</p>
<p>Does your University accept the International Baccalaureate?</p>	<p>Yes - typical entry requirements will be in the range 30- 36 points at IB with subject specific requirements at the Higher Level for some degree programmes. The precise offer and subject specific requirements depend on the degree programme applied for.</p>
