Does your University accept the HKCEE and HKALE for admission to your University?	Yes, HKCEE grades are considered equivalent to GCSE. HKALE grades are equivalent to A-level (apart from Maths and Physics, where we recognize that a B-grade in HKALE is equivalent to an A at A-level)
What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University?	Please refer to the UG prospectus for the specific subject and grade requirements of each course. Information can also be found on our website: www.manchester.ac.uk
Do students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications have to sit an entrance examination to enter your University?	No. But Medicine requires face-to-face interview with candidates.
Is there a language proficiency test that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must take?	Students are expected to provide proof of their English level such as an IELTS or TOEFL score. Achievement of grade B in English at HKCEE and HKALE exams is also acceptable for entry.
Is there a standard on an international English scale that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must reach?	English requirement varies from course to course. Some require a minimum of IELTS 6.0 whereas the majority courses ask for 6.5 or 7.0.
Are there any other tests that students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University must take? When must they be taken?	No.
Is there an entry quota that applies to students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University?	No. For undergraduate Medicine and Dentistry courses, the UK government imposes quota of 30 for Medicine and 14-16 for Dentistry for non-EU students.

Is consideration given to factors other than examination performance for overseas students wishing to apply for entry to your University?	Apart from the academic results, academic reference, personal statement, interview performance and other supporting information will also be taken into consideration while making decisions.

Does your University accept students if they are under the age of 18 at the time of commencing studies?	We would expect the students to be of the age of 17 or above when enrolled. Individual cases will be considered if student is below the age of 17.
