These students will be required to take an English Placement Test upon Enrollment.</p> <p>Applicants who meet the following composite scores will not have to take the English Placement Test or English as Second Language Classes: 85 on the internet based TOEFL or 6.5 on the IELTS.</p>	NA	NA
