Does your University accept the HKCEE and HKALE for admission to your University?	University of Nevada, Reno (UNR) accepts HKALE which is an equivalent to 6 th Form (12 grade in high school) where students receive diplomas. UNR does not however accept HKCEE because it is comparable to 4 th Form (11 th grade).
What are the entry requirements for a student with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications entering your University?	Students with HKALE must have a minimum final high school GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. International transfer students need to have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and 24 transferable credits. International applicants must submit satisfactory score of 61 on the iBT TOEFL, 500 (PBT), or 173 (CBT). They may also apply to study English at the University of Nevada, Reno Intensive English Language Center (IELC) and may be eligible for conditional acceptance. Starting in Fall 2007, international applicants will be able to submit IELTS scores for admission in addition to TOEFL. International applicants must submit satisfactory score of 61 on the iBT TOEFL, 500 (PBT), or 173 (CBT). They may also apply to study English at Intensive English Language Center and may be eligible for conditional acceptance. Starting in Fall 2007, international applicants will be able to submit IELTS scores for admission in addition to TOEFL. International applicants must submit satisfactory score of 61 on the iBT TOEFL, 500 (PBT), or 173 (CBT). Starting in Fall 2007, international applicants will be able to submit IELTS scores for admission in addition to TOEFL.
Is there an entry quota that applies to students with HKCEE and HKALE qualifications wishing to enter your University?	No.

Is consideration given to factors other than examination performance for overseas students wishing to apply for entry to your University?	No. If international applicants do not meet the minimum GPA requirement, they can appeal the admission decision to the Special Admission Committee.
Does your University accept the International Baccalaureate?	Yes. The applicability of IB credits towards satisfying specific major/degree requirements is determined by individual colleges and departments.
Does your University accept students if they are under the age of 18 at the time of commencing studies?	Yes. High school students may be admitted and may enroll, subject to approval of appropriate university officials.
