### Registration for Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE) 2023

The Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) announces that registration for the 2023 HKDSE will be accepted from 13 September to 6 October 2022 for both school and private candidates.

School candidates should register for the HKDSE through their schools and private candidates have to register online via the HKDSE Registration System at the HKDSE Examination Online Services (<https://www.hkdse.hkeaa.edu.hk/>).

Prospective private candidates should note the following registration details:

#### 1. Entry Qualifications

A person may enter for the 2023 HKDSE as a private candidate provided he/she satisfies one of the following requirements:

- (a) Sat the previous HKDSE or an equivalent examination, or
- (b) Reached the age of 19 by 1 January 2023, or
- (c) Completed or is currently pursuing a non-HKDSE curriculum equivalent to Secondary 6 as determined by the HKEAA in 2022/2023.

All candidates should ensure that they can comply with necessary statutory requirements for sitting the HKDSE in Hong Kong, such as applicable visa or stay conditions, quarantine requirements, etc. before the examinations. #### 2. Subjects Offered

The following categories of subjects will be offered in the September registration:

- **Category A** - 24 Senior Secondary subjects
- **Category B** - 45 Applied Learning subjects approved by the Education Bureau, which are offered to school candidates only

The June registration pertaining to the Category C November 2022 series had been closed.

Each candidate may enter for a maximum of eight subjects, including any Categories A, B and C subjects.

### 3. Examination Fees

The Finance Committee of the Legislative Council has approved a financial commitment for the Government to pay the examination fees for eligible school candidates sitting the 2023 HKDSE. This scheme is not applicable to private candidates.
