HKEAA Urges Public to Beware of Fraudulent HKDSE Email

The Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) urges members of the public to be vigilant about and cautious of a fraudulent email concerning the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE).

The email was sent by the email account 'hkeaaappealcentre@gmail.com'. It requested that candidates provide their HKDSE results information to handle the applications for results appeal. The HKEAA has emphasised that the Authority has no affiliation with this email and has reported the case to the Hong Kong Police Force.

The HKEAA's email addresses are under the domain name '@hkeaa.edu.hk'. After the issuance of HKDSE results notices, the Authority will NOT invite candidates to apply for rechecking and remarking on HKDSE subjects, nor will it ask candidates to provide personal or results information through email or other channels.
