It is the candidates' responsibility to check carefully the relevant examination timetables (including IAL / GCE / IGCSE / GCSE) before submitting entries so as to avoid timetable clashes among subjects entered and prohibited combination of subjects with IAL examinations, or across different examinations under Pearson Edexcel (i.e. GCE / IGCSE / GCSE), or across different examinations of other examination boards. Candidates should avoid entering the subjects which are scheduled in the same exam session (i.e. AM or PM session).
