


TOPIK(Test of Proficiency in Korean) IBT Guidelines for Test Takers

Test Overview

Concept

- A Korean language proficiency test administered by the South Korean government.
- Designed to assess the Korean language skills of overseas Koreans and foreigners whose native language is not Korean.
- An internet-based test that allows Korean language learners worldwide to take the test conveniently.
- A government-administered language proficiency test with the same validity and grading system as the paper-based TOPIK (PBT).

Purpose

- Evaluate the Korean language proficiency of overseas Koreans and foreigners and provide direction for Korean language learning.
- Utilize the test results for admission to Korean universities, employment, and residency qualifications of overseas Koreans and foreigners.
- Provide standards for Korean language education and evaluation and contribute to expanding Korean language education.

Background

「Higher Education Act」

Article 34-7 (Selection of Foreign Students, etc.) ① The president of a university may use language proficiency as part of the admission process for overseas Koreans and foreign students.

- ② The Minister of Education may administer the TOPIK to evaluate the Korean language proficiency among the language abilities described in paragraph 1.
- ③ Matters related to the timing, method, measures against violation, and other necessary matters regarding the TOPIK under paragraph 2 shall be prescribed by the presidential decree.

^r Enforcement Decree of the Higher Education Act

Article 42-5 (Test of Proficiency in Korean) ① The Test of Proficiency in Korean under Article 34-7 (2) of the Act (hereinafter referred to as the "Test of Proficiency in Korean") shall be administered domestically and abroad at least once a year.

- ② The Minister of Education shall formulate and publicly announce a plan for the implementation of the Test of Proficiency in Korean for the following year by the end of October each year.
- ③ The Test of Proficiency in Korean can be divided into listening, reading, writing, and speaking.
- 4 Measures against cheating in the Test of Proficiency in Korean are shown in Annex Table 1-2.
- ⑤ Those who wish to take the Test of Proficiency in Korean shall pay a fee determined and publicly notified by the Minister of Education.
- (6) In addition to the matters stipulated in paragraphs (1) through (5), details necessary for the implementation of the Test of Proficiency in Korean shall be determined and publicly notified by the Minister of Education.

Regulations on Delegation and Entrustment of Administrative Authority

Article 22 (Jurisdiction of the Ministry of Education) ① The Minister of Education delegates the authority to conduct the TOPIK under Article 34-7(2) of the Higher Education Act to the Head of the National Institute for International Education (NIIED).

- O Korean Language Proficiency Test administered by the South Korean government
- O A standardized test that measures the Korean language skills of non-native Korean speakers
- O A convenient and better accessible Internet-based test for global Korean learners
- O An official language test that has the same validity and grading system as the TOPIK Paper-based test
- * TOPIK IBT (Test Of Proficiency In Korean Internet-Based Test)

2. Who can take the TOPIK IBT?

- O Anyone can take the TOPIK IBT
- Anyone who can provide ID card / Passport for identity verification

 - Asia Pacific: Taiwan, Mongolia, Vietnam, Singapore, Uzbekistan, Indonesia, Thailand, Philippines, Hong Kong, Guam, Hawaii
 - Europe: Rumania, Lithuania, United Kingdom

D. Question Types

- O Multiple Choice(Radio Button): Choosing the appropriate answer out of four options
- O Word Insertion: Choosing the most appropriate answer for the blank in the reading passage
- O Sentence Insertion: Choosing the appropriate place for the given sentence in the reading passage
- O Drag and Drop: Arranging the given sentences in order
- O Sentence Completion(Short answer): Entering the appropriate answer in the blank to complete the sentence

O Essay writing: Writing an essay on a given topic within the suggested word count range

8. Test Result

- O Test Result Release: Test-takers can check their test result and score reports within 4 to 5 weeks after the exam date.
- O Check your score
- Nonmember: www.topik.go.kr > Check Your Score > Select Test Session, Registration Number, and Birthdate
- O Validity period: 2 years after the release of test score
- * No score report will be given for absentees or test takers who violated test regulations or whose identity has not been verified.







On the Test Day

1. Your Proof of Registration

Proof of Registration containing your registration number will be distributed to candidates on the test day. The HKEAA will send you an email containing the test details, i.e. Exam time, Exam centre details, etc. approximately ONE week before the test.

2. Check Test Center Location and Test Start Time

You should refer to the email HKEAA sent to you for the finalized test centre details and test time.

3. Arrive at the Test Center

- O The test center will be opened one hour before the start time. Candidates are advised to arrive at the test center **at least 45 minutes** before the test starts
- O Candidates should present the registered identification documents for identity verification
- O Staff reserves the right to deny the admission of candidates whose personal information or photo shown on ID mismatches that on our record.

4. Before Test

A. Enter the Test Room

- O Enter the test room following the Centre Supervisor's instructions
 - Be seated according to the seat no. assigned by the center supervisor
 - No other items except the provided Proof of Registration, ID document, and locker key (if any) are allowed to be put on the desk
 - Your personal belongings, including your electronic devices, should be switched off and stored in the locker located outside the test room
 - * Candidates cannot use, carry, or wear any electronic devices in the test room including but not limited to mobile phones and smartwatches.
 - * Eating or drinking is strictly prohibited in the test room.

- * No stationery and tissues can be brought into the test room. Note-taking is NOT allowed during the test
- O Preliminary ID Check
 - Provide your identification document to the Centre Supervisor/Invigilator for identity verification.
 - Test takers whose identity cannot be confirmed, including those without identification documents, will be asked to leave the test room immediately.

B. 40 minutes before the Test

- O Closing of Test room entrance
 - The entrance of the test rooms will be **closed 40 minutes before the start time**. No latecomers will be admitted.
- O ID Check (1st)
 - Provide your identification document to the Centre Supervisor/Invigilator for identity verification in test system.
 - Test takers whose identity cannot be confirmed, including those without identification documents, will be asked to leave the test room immediately.
 - Be seated according to the seat no. assigned by the center supervisor

O Test-taker login

- Login: Enter your registration number, date of birth, and your signature using the mouse
- Check and confirm your name, date of birth, and registration number on the screen
- Check and adjust headphone volume. Test takers are responsible for checking headphones if it is working correctly before test. Seek help from the invigilator if needed.
- Check and accept the test rules and security agreement.

C. 15 minutes before the test

O Click the <Start Test> button and wait according to the invigilator's instructions.

5. Starting the Test

The test will start automatically according to the scheduled test time.

6. During the Test

- O ID Check (2nd) during Reading Test
 - Provide your identification document to the Centre Supervisor/Invigilator for identity verification during examination.

Test Rules

- TOPIK IBT does NOT have scheduled breaks in between sections.
- Test takers cannot leave the test room and use restrooms during the test.
- If a test taker must leave the test room for an unavoidable reason, you must be accompanied by an invigilator. A report will be filed for the temporary leave.
- The test will not be temporarily paused, and no additional time will be added if you leave the test room during the test.

7. End of Test

- O Confirm the end of the test
 - Test takers should confirm whether the test has ended by submitting answers
 - Test takers are responsible for any negligence in failing to submit their test answers.
- O Early termination of the test
 - No early termination is allowed in both TOPIK I and TOPIK II tests. When test takers complete the test earlier and request to leave the test site, you have to wait in a designated area until the official test end time. No Test results will be provided to early leavers.

8. After the Test

- O Leave the test room
 - Test takers should wait for the instructions from the Centre Supervisor, who will confirm the test results have been submitted, before allowing you to leave.
 - Make sure to take away all your personal belongings stored in the locker and return the locker keys to the test centre staff before leaving the exam venue.
