

Reminder

S.4 2nd –term presentation on reader

Steps to follow –

1. Remind students that when they communicate with someone:

7% is actual words
38% is the one or emotion
55% is non verbal or body language

2. Students watch CDs/ examples and comment –

3. Students write notes for their presentations

4. Teachers check notes written by students

5. Public speaking skills preparation

- Class activities on –
 - (1) preparing a powerful and captivating voice
 - (2) use of voice
- Teachers are encouraged to video students' performance

6. Students do final presentation in class –

- Students do (1) self-assessment (2) peer assessment
- Teachers evaluate students' performance
