10 mins	Dialogues in dramatic situation	Pair work, discuss the given dramatic situation by the question words	
15 mins	Context in a drama	Pair work, refer to the dialogue again, but with a context	
	Prologue/Epilogue/ Subtext/ Stage direction	Students trying to add those elements in a drama script	
10 mins	Stress and intonation in a drama	Students practice different stress and intonation	
20 mins	Identifying and expressing different emotions, feelings and motivations	Group work Information gap activity	
20 mins	Appreciating and evaluating a drama performance	Students watch a drama performance and learn to comment on it.
